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## GreenGenerations: Start of the Piloting Activities

Our School Pioneers: Participation in an Erasmus Pilot Program on Climate Change and Intergenerational Learning in the frame of Green Generations project (2022-1-FR01-KA220-SCH-000085830).

Our school, Alexandria 1st Primary School, is participating in a pioneering Erasmus project on climate change and intergenerational learning. The project which has been implementing for about two years is a fruit of cooperation between schools, educational institutions and NGOs from France, Romania, Bulgaria, Cyprus and Greece.

The theme of the project combines awareness of the climate crisis with the concept of intergenerational learning, i.e. the exchange of knowledge and experiences between different generations. The goal is to educate young people, but also to strengthen interaction with older ones, to utilize the wisdom of the past and the solutions of the future to protect the planet.

During the first two years, the project partners developed comprehensive educational materials, which includes teaching modules and activities related to climate change. These educational materials (GreenGenerations Curriculum) will now be used for the pilot phase of the project. Our school, together with other partner schools, will participate in the pilot implementation. Our students and teachers will evaluate teaching approaches, participate in activities and collaborate with groups from other countries to exchange ideas and experiences. Our participation in this project is a unique opportunity to display our local community in a European collaborative environment, enrich our teaching approach and actively contribute to raising awareness about climate change.

With enthusiasm and pride, we await the results of the pilot phase and hope that this initiative will pave the way for the dissemination of sustainable practices and the strengthening of cooperation at an international level. Our school is leading the way for the future of the planet!

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
